



Saint Cosme - "Little James Basket Press" Vin de Pays d'Oc - white - 2009

Fermented and aged in vat

It is not possible to live without a good, aromatic and refreshing bottle of white wine in the fridge, ready to be tasted with an unexpected friend. It is very important! This is what we think about when we make this sauvignon/viognier. Its quality related to price is always exceptionnal. The mountains of Minervois have a cool microclimate very well adapted to the sauvignon grape. Our viognier comes from a vine which is a "selection massale" from Condrieu, planted in 1982. We work and ferment these grapes on a very classical way. We look for freshness, energy and aromatic expression: this wine should taste like an elixir of youth! It can be tasted for aperitive and works with many different kinds of food: roasted vegetables, little rocky fishes, stilton, bleu de bresse, asparagus, chicken with morels, risotto, pasta with mascarpone...etc...

Little James red retains itself. Little James white is explosive.
