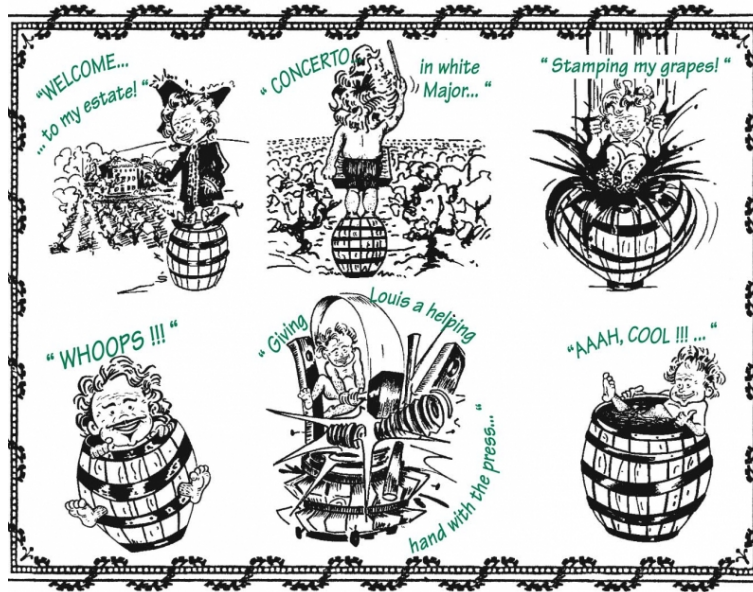


LITTLE JAMES' BASKET PRESS

Clearly, we don't talk about the same category but the most important is to love what we do, love the well done work. My father taught me that and told me that 1000 times but I fully understood that much later. This is to have a logical of artisan and this has nothing to do with the prestige a wine has or hasn't got. What is important is to be able to talk to you about the wines I make. Ideally these wines should be able to talk to you directly on a nice way. If there is a little bit of emotion, it is even better. This is why I like to dedicate myself to the « little wines » as well because the pleasure for an artisan is when the work has been perfectly done, with love at every stage. When this good work is achieved, the « terroir », the magical of a few soils, the mystery of the climates that forge every day....I don't have any kind of control on these ...
