Little James' Basket Press white – Pays d'Oc 2014 Viognier - Sauvignon.

Winemaking and ageing in vats.

In 2013, I had used more Sauvignon than Viognier to « tune » at the best the balance of Little James. This year, I went for the opposite for the same reason. Blending Viognier with Sauvignon is not usual : it is almost impossible to find in the market a bottle of Sauvignon-Viognier. I don't really understand why as I find their complementarity and their ability to marry absolutely remarkable. The Languedoc area offers to the growers this fantastic opportunity to be a large land of freedom : let's enjoy that. The new label of Little James will keep its comic dimension and will be more informative at the same time: I leave you discover it. Very aromatic and intense, the Little James white 2014 is a good successor of its predecessors : it is our thirst-quenching white wine. Its only goal is to give you some immediate enjoyment.
