

Saint Cosme - "Crozes-Hermitage" AOP Crozes-Hermitage - red - 2011

100% Serine (ancient syrah).

Granitic slopes.

Aged for twelve months: 20% in new oak - 40% in one year old barrels - 40% in two years old barrels. Clearly the Hermitage region benefited of the best weather in 2011. The wines are successful, especially in the slope area. Our Crozes Hermitage comes from the best slopes of Gervans, Larnage and Erôme and it is often close to a Hermitage level of quality. Let's recall that the slope represent only 20% of the appellation.. The syrah grape looks different depending on the terroir where it is grown. What is typical of Crozes-Hermitage is the intensity of fresh fruit. It always gives a dimension of pleasure. Everyone should have bottles of Crozes in his cellar...

The 2011 can be drunk young and up to 6 years old.

Chemenee soot, red currant, black pepper, incense. Bottled without filtration.
