Yellow clay and limestony marl from Miocène at the Lieu-dit "Le Claux"

Aged for twelve months: 30% in new oak -40% in one year old barrels - 30% in two years old barrels.

The history of Le Claux, strongly related to the history of our family, is special. Sometimes when I walk in Le Claux, I think about my great-uncles and my grand-mother whom I never knew. Le Claux, just like Hominis Fides have been both planted around 1880; just after the phylloxera crisis. These vines are witnesses of the new viticultural dynamic encouraged in these times. Le Claux 2010, (more austere than Le Poste and Hominis Fides) will be, just like the 2007, a superbe wine to keep. With its enigmatic profile of burgundy wine and its aromas of campher, it holds a lot of promises.

Bottled without filtration
