A step up, the 2020 Saint Joseph comes all from the northern part of the Northern Rhône, and it's medium-bodied and elegant, with good ripeness in its darker berry, violet, flower, and wet granite-like nuances. It's another balanced, seamless red from Louis, and the 2019 vintage is a beauty for the Northern Rhône. Tasting date: 1/25/2022
