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In “9 Southern Rhône Wines for Late-Summer Sipping,” James Molesworth provides a selection of new releases from the Southern Rhône. He notes how the vintages vary: “The 2017s are fruit-filled and forward in style, light on structure and ideal for drinking now and in the near-term. The 2016s are another matter altogether, brimming with dark fruit and with ample grip; it's the best vintage in recent memory for the south.” He includes CHÂTEAU DE SAINT COSME among the selections, mentioning it as a “Gigondas benchmark”.
