## **Vinous**

SAINT COSME Crozes-Hermitage 2013 – 91 points

"Glass-staining ruby. Vibrant black currant and cherry aromas are complicated by suggestions of black pepper, olive and smoky Indian spices. Taut and nervy on entry, then fleshier in the mid-palate, offering gently sweet black and blue fruit flavors and a hint of licorice. Shows very good energy and lift on the clinging finish, which features silky tannins and an echo of sappy dark fruit."
