This is packed together, with taut iron cables providing a platform for mouthwatering bitter plum, cassis and blackberry reduction flavors. Sage, bay tobacco and warm earth notes play equally important roles, adding superior range and depth. Everything pulls together through the finish, though the end point takes some time to reach. Best from 2025 through 2040. 250 cases made, 105 cases imported. — JM Issue: Dec 15, 2021"

Also all Grenache from a single vineyard just down from the estate, the 2019 Gigondas Le Claux offers more minerality, as well as structure, and is another 2019 that's going to benefit from bottle age. Complex bouquet of red currants, loamy soil and dried Garrigue, camphor, and licorice all emerge from the glass and this beauty has building tannins, flawless balance and a great, great finish.
